What? A 13.1 mile running race, featuring elite runners and 8,500 participants. This race is held annually and organized by the Big Sur Marathon Foundation.

Where? Downtown Monterey, Cannery Row, Pacific Grove coastline and downtown, Coastal Recreation Trail

When? Sunday morning, November 10, beginning at 6:50 a.m. and ending at 11 a.m.

Why? A key economic driver for Monterey County (more than \$8 million in economic impact); brings international publicity to our area; money is raised for local charity groups.





GETTING TO WORK ON SUNDAY MORNING, NOVEMBER 10 for employees in New Monterey, Cannery Row and Pacific Grove

In order to handle thousands of runners, this event necessitates the temporary closure of several streets for a few hours on race morning. **IF YOU'RE DRIVING IN** from outside the area, here are the various ways to travel westbound to New Monterey, Cannery Row and Pacific Grove:

- 1. Until 5:30 a.m., westbound travel is available <u>through the tunnel</u> from Washington Street (Del Monte Ave. will be closed at 3 a.m. in the downtown area from Sloat to Washington St.)
- 2. Until 6:15 a.m., westbound travel is available via Pacific Avenue
- 3. After 6:15 a.m., until the downtown Monterey streets are reopened after 9 a.m., all traffic is being rerouted over Holman Highway 68.

BUS TRAVEL: Lines 1 & 2 to New Monterey and Pacific Grove will be running, but may be detoured and delayed while the tunnel is closed until approximately 8:30 a.m. when it is re-opened to traffic.

PARKING: Lighthouse Avenue in downtown Pacific Grove will be closed until 9 a.m.; Cannery Row will be closed until 11 a.m. Please make arrangements to park off site until these roads are reopened.
